

## WELDER II

SasquatchXC, or SXC for short, designs, manufactures, and sells expedition campers capable of accessing remote, rugged terrain. The Welder will join a fast-growing team that take pride in their work.

### Summary:

As a Welder, you will help with all fabrication processes of building an Off-Road Camper and associated products at SXC. Beyond technical expertise, this position requires you to have organizational skills and learn detailed product knowledge. You will be responsible for preparing parts for welding, welding, and preparing products that you build for powder coating.

### Key Responsibilities:

- Perform activities such as precision cutting, grinding, preparation for welding and powder coating.
- Set up and layout parts and assemblies by following specifications such as diagrams and fixture settings. Ensure that welding work remains in compliance with drawings and specifications.
- TIG Welding aluminum components in accordance with set specifications, maintaining dimension, strength, and evenness of surfaces that need to be welded.
- Ensure quality control processes are being followed and perform inspections of parts and assemblies. Ensure that any defects or variances in quality are addressed immediately.
- Ensure any quality control concerns are raised to management immediately and corrective action when needed.
- Follow production scheduling priorities to optimize productivity and efficiency during manufacturing.
- Communicate deadline, design, or supply chain issues and equipment needs to management immediately.
- Establish and maintain positive working relationships with other employees.
- Communicate and interact effectively with management and team members through verbal and written means.
- Maintain clean and tidy workstations. Understand and implement basic 5S principles.
- Maintain high level of accountability for performance and quality of work.
- Perform other duties and assist other departments as required.

### Minimum Requirements:

- 2+ years of experience TIG welding aluminum.
- Ability to read, understand, and follow detailed drawings, schematics, and test procedures.
- Ability to measure, cut, and weld to extremely tight tolerances.
- Ability to safely run power tools, including saws, sanders, drills and grinders.
- Possess dexterity skills needed to work with hand tools, test equipment, and computers.
- Willingness to learn manufacturing processes and be able to effectively troubleshoot problems.
- Adaptable to changing work environments, including toolbox and workstation changes, 5S optimizations.
- Communicate time off requests to management with sufficient advance, allowing time for planning.
- A High School Diploma and Welding certificate from a Trade School is required, experience in a fabrication environment is desired.
